Dear Parents,

As you are aware, our district has adopted Everyday Mathematics as the core mathematics' curriculum for our schools. A website with online programs to assist your child accompanies this curriculum. These programs can be utilized on any computer that has internet access. This letter will explain the procedure for accessing them.

## Using Everyday Math Online at Home

1. In a web browser - such as Internet Explorer, Firefox, or Safari - go to the *Everyday Math Online* home page at <https://www.everydaymathonline.com>. You may wish to save this address as a "favorite" or "bookmark" in your browser.
2. On your first visit, click the **Support** link in the upper-right corner of the page. Read the system requirements, and run the **Computer Test** to test the technology on your computer and see what you may need to update. The most common updates are to:
  - Install or update the Adobe Flash and Adobe Shockwave plug-ins.
  - Allow pop-up windows from "everydaymathonline.com" and "emgames.com".

3. Click  in the upper left of the page.

4. On the **STUDENT LOGIN** page, fill in your child's "Login:" name exactly as shown on the Login Card sent home by your child's teacher. After you are done typing it, click the **Start** button.

5. You will either see a password box, or series of buttons to click (*see picture*). Enter the password shown on your card,<sup>2</sup> and then click the **Log In** button.

6. You are now logged in and may click any of the Launch buttons you see.



Feel free to contact your child's teacher with any questions about the programs. If you do not have internet access, a CD can be provided.
