Dear Parents/Guardians,

The New Jersey Department of Education, under advisement of the New Jersey Tuberculosis Medical Advisory Board, requires student tuberculin skin testing when a student enters a school system in the United States for the first time if born in a high TB incidence country or when transferring into a New Jersey school system directly from a high TB incidence country. Your child's enrollment record indicates that he or she is required to have tuberculin skin testing.

Any student with parents claiming religious exemption cannot be compelled to submit to tuberculin skin testing. Please contact your school nurse for further information.

Please have your personal physician administer the Mantoux Tuberculin and have him/her send the report to the school nurse within two weeks.

You may contact your school nurse if you have any questions concerning this test.
